Informing parents

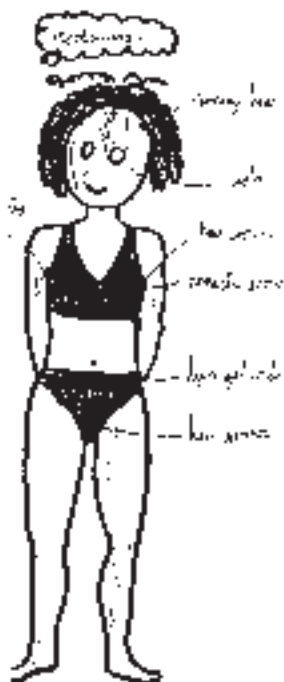
We sent a letter home to inform parents and gave them the option of coming into school to look at the materials.
